

Storaton Community Radio have returned to the airwaves this week and though I didn't come across them till Sunday, they seem to have been on the air most of the week as letters had already started arriving at the mailing address and many listeners were already aware of their 13s-18s Night-out to be held at Ma Baker's on 28th October. Radio Mersey Waves have been on the air every day this week. They say this is to provide something for their school-age listeners to listen to during the $\frac{1}{2}$ -term holiday. Announcements made this week-end suggest that they may be planning to stay on the air every day next week as it is the $\frac{1}{2}$ -term holiday in Liverpool.

STORETON COMMUNITY RADIO 1026kHz: 91, New Hey Road, Woodchurch Estate, Birkenhead, Merseyside L49 7NE. Jim Browne mentioned on CRI that this station were back on the air, but when checked at 11:30am Sunday, the signal was intermittent and eventually disappeared. At noon the theme tune was heard and programming began. The line-up noted was: Noon-3pm Andy Sloane; 3pm-5pm Paul Western; 5pm-7pm Brian "C" aided by Misty; 7pm-10pm Larry James; 10pm-Midnight Carrie Ann. Any programming beyond midnight wasn't noted.

CENTRAL RADIO INT. 1404kHz: 18, Glynne Street, Orrell, Bootle, Merseyside L20 6DF.

The station say that they were on the air on Monday but they weren't noted. It seems that the DTI were on the prowl and that Phil Davies closed down the station at approximately 4pm. The station also announce Friday operation but were not noted this week. They are looking for DJs for their Friday programmes, which may not yet have commenced. They opened at 10am on Saturday and heard were:- 10am-Noon Jim Lowe; Noon-2pm Jim Browne; 2pm-4pm Phil Davies; 4pm-6pm Tom Webb; 6pm-8pm Charlie Browne??; 8pm-10pm John Sanderson; 10pm-Midnight close-down Jeff Thompson. The early part of Sunday's schedule wasn't noted but it is believed that they opened at 8am and the line-up was:- 8am-10am Charlie Browne; 10am-Noon Jim Browne; Noon-2pm Jim Lowe; 2pm-4pm Phil Davies; 4pm-6pm Tom Webb; 6pm-9pm John Sanderson; 9pm-Midnight close-down Jeff Thompson

CONCEPT RADIO 104.3MHz: 18, Glynne Street, Orrell, Bootle, Merseyside L20 6DF.

This station appears to be Sundays only, with their own programming from 7pm onwards. On Sunday they spent most of the day relaying Central Radio, but both Jim Browne and Tom Webb announced over CRI that they were on 1404kHz MW and also on 104.3MHz FM via the transmitter of Concept Radio. At other times there were plenty of "interruptions" on 104.3MHz to say that this was Concept Radio relaying CRI. They appear to have relayed CRI till 7pm, after which their own programming consisted of:- 7pm-9pm Jim Lowe; 9pm-11:16pm Tom Webb; 11:16 onward Jim Lowe. Announcements suggested that the station might continue after the announced Midnight close-down, but if so, then details weren't noted. Reception in this area is still difficult due to ILR Signal Radio on the same frequency, but CRI announced that their engineer would be helping Concept Radio to adjust to a new frequency in the expectation that the latter's signal would then get out over a much wider area

RADIO MERSEY WAVES 1242kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 7UW

As stated above, the station have been on the air all week. On Monday they followed their normal format but with Keith the Chief standing in for Edward Bear 7pm-9pm. On Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday the daytime schedule from 8am was mostly undertaken by Dave Collins, Mark Newman, Paul James and DJC with Peter Thomas and Martin Miller standing-in for Paul Woods till Friday. The evening schedules have been undertaken by Mark Newman, Tara, Tony Coltrane, Keith the Chief and DJC. The station appears to have been closing-down between 3am and 8am although the carrier has remained on the air. The Friday schedule varied this week and heard were:- 8am-11am Dave Collins; 11am-1pm DJC; 1pm-3pm Alan Bates; 3pm-5pm Paul Woods; 5pm-7pm KtC; 7pm-10pm Tara; 10pm-Midnight Mark Newman; Midnight-1am KtC and 1am-3am DJC. Saturday also saw a revised line-up of:- 8am-10am Dave Collins; 10am-2pm Mark Wright; 2pm-4pm DJC; 4pm- 6pm Paul Woods; 6pm-8pm Tara; 8pm-10pm Dave Collins and 10pm to 1am close-down Mark Newman. The Sunday schedule was as normal, except 5pm-7pm Paul Woods in place of KtC and 7pm-10pm Dave Collins in for Martin Miller. 10pm-Midnight was Mark Newman, but the programming after 11pm wasn't noted.
