All day Saturday, Manx Hadio on 1368kHz were suffering severe interference, possibly from a local free radio station, but it proved impossible to separate out the other station with the gear available at this location.

## UNIDENTIFIED 105.8 or 105.9 MHz

From 9pm on Sunday night a station was noted playing continuous music on 105.8-105.9 MHz. It closed down without identification at 9:45pm. The station is believed to have been K-Sound Radio, who announce 105.2 MHz. A few weeks ago, Tom Webb said that both South Wirral Radio and K-Sound operate on 105.9 MHz. The signal strength is very low for both stations who possibly bought the "flea-power" DIY FM transmitter kits that are reputed to be on sale at a certain shop in Eirkenhead.

Apart from Radio Veronica, there seems to be very little activity from the Liverpool area with no other stations currently being noted.
