MERSEYSIDE FREE RADIO SCENE

Week ending Sunday 27th July 1986

Just three stations have been noted here this week, with Radio Mersey Waves being unable to fulfill parts of their schedule.

RADIO VERONICA 104.7 MHz: 81, Lark Lane, Liverpool L17 8UP.

In spite of announcements that this station operates on Fridays, their signal has yet to by found on this day. Heard this week have been:-

All the times given in the schedules for this station are "give or take a few minutes" It still isn't possible to receive this station on anything less than a communications receiver, but the operators say that they hope to be increasing power shortly.

RADIO JULIE 104.8 MHz: 15, Pitch Close, Greasby, Wirral, Merseyside L49 2RR.

The signal in Liverpool (at my place of work) is extremely weak and barely heard even with the receiver in the open air. The Friday programmes before 5pm tend to go unhead. Noted this week have been:-

RADIO MERSEY WAVES 1242kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 70W

This station seem to be short of DJs and have not been able to stay on the air, with both continuous music and carrier only noted at times. Peter Thomas didn't do llpm-lam slot on Monday night as he went home ill. On Saturday, Tara's show started 70 minutes late. She said she was only a few minutes late for her show but had been unable to gain admission to the studio.
